COMPANY OVERVIEW

F&M Bancorp/Farmers & Merchants Bank

Company Description: F&M Bancorp (the Company) (FMBI) is an Ohio financial holding company headquartered in Miamisburg, Ohio. The Company is a registered bank holding company under the Bank Holding Company Act of 1956, as amended. The Company is the parent company for its wholly owned subsidiary; Farmers & Merchants Bank (FMB)(the Bank) formed in 1923. The Bank operates offices in Germantown, West Carrollton, Miamisburg, New Lebanon, and Springboro.

Message from the Chairman/CEO: Your Board of Directors are pleased to report that our Company continued strong performance, throughout 2025 in key areas of asset, loan and deposit growth and earnings. Our loan portfolio continues to grow reaching \$286,956,000 at year-end 2025. Our Company exceeded 2025 year-end income projections recording \$5,537,000 in earnings. Key Insights of Performance: FMBI generated growth across all major metrics. Net income showing the strongest growth rate in 2025. Improved Profitability and Efficiency achieved with both net interest margin (NIM) and efficiency ratio driving increased net income for YE 2025. The Net Interest Margin (see Key Highlights) of FMB indicates more efficient earning from lending and investing activities an operating focus of your management. FMBI Shareholder Value increased in 2025 with investors benefiting from increased dividends and growth in fair market value per share reflecting positive returns for shareholders.

Shareholder Return: The fair market value (FMV), of our stock, as of YE 2025 is \$130.60 per share increased from \$118.25 YE 2024. Price per share increased by \$12.35 per share (ASK) up 10.44% from YE 2024 and up 12.30% per share from year-end 2024 when including dividends. Calculated P/BV 114%. Shareholders have received total cash dividends year-to-date, as of 2025 of approximately \$750,547/\$2.20 per share. Your Board is appreciative of investor confidence in FMBI and is pleased to provide this report on the financial soundness of your Bank. (*See Stock Chart Back Page*)


